REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The City of Hailey is seeking statements of Qualifications from engineering firms for assistance with the Big Wood River TMDL and EPA NPDES Permit renewal expected to occur in late 2009.

Applicants are expected to provide the following minimum information:

1. Applicants must show substantial firm expertise in working with both IDEQ and EPA on NPDES permits and with the TMDL process. Subcontracting for expertise, including legal advice, not available within the submitting firm will be considered and should be noted in the application.
2. Applicants must list all team members expected to participate in the project and list individual responsibilities and qualifications.
3. Applicants must indicate any unusual issues or problems that they may anticipate in performing the work.
4. Applicants need to meet all requirements of the State of Idaho Department of Environmental Quality, professional liability indemnification requirements (IDAPA 50.01.12, Subsection 050.05.d) for State Matching Fund participation.
5. Applicants must be licensed engineers in the State of Idaho.

Qualified firms must submit a full statement of qualifications to the office of the City Engineer at 115 S. Main, Hailey, Idaho 83333 no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 3, 2009 to be considered. Please contact Thomas Hellen at 208-788-9830, Ext 14 for additional information concerning this project. The Mayor and City Council will select a short list at the Council meeting on April 27, 2009 and those firms will be asked to submit proposals for completing the project as outlined by the City of Hailey.

PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING SCOPE OF WORK

- I. Review of Big Wood River TMDL:
 - A. Review both the EPA approved TMDL and DEQ Post-TMDL Study for accuracy and impacts.
 - B. Provide a written report detailing possible next steps with both DEQ and EPA.
 - C. Provide a report on Reclaimed Water as an alternative treatment and disposal method including possible impacts on the NPDES Permit.

- II. Assist with dialogue with EPA and DEQ during the City of Hailey NPDES permit renewal:
 - A. Meet with EPA at beginning of notice of permit renewal.
 - B. Provide additional engineering studies as needed to provide back-up to the City of Hailey proposals to modify TMDL limits.
 - C. Provide information on alternative permit options including possible impacts and requirements.
