

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The City of Hailey is seeking statements of qualifications from engineering firms to provide preliminary planning, surveying, design, cost estimates and citizen information meeting services for the reconstruction of a 2.44 mile long collector street in the Woodside Subdivision. The City of Hailey is applying for federal assistance to help fund the project.

Applicants are expected to provide the following minimum information:

1. Applicants should show any firm expertise in working with US DOT or other federally funded grants. Subcontracting for expertise not available within the submitting firm will be considered and should be noted in the application.
2. Applicants must list all team members expected to participate in the project and list individual responsibilities and qualifications.
3. Applicants must indicate any unusual issues or problems that they may anticipate in performing the work.
4. Applicants must be licensed engineers in the State of Idaho.

The selection of the recommended firm will be made by a city staff selection committee based upon the criteria outlined below. The maximum point value of each criterion is shown in parentheses:

Qualified firms must submit three hard copies of a full statement of qualifications labeled Woodside Boulevard Reconstruction Project – Design Professional Services to the office of the City Engineer at 115 S. Main, Hailey, Idaho 83333 no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 15, 2010 to be considered.

The Mayor and City Council are expected to ratify a recommended firm at the Council meeting on September 27, 2010 and that firm will be asked to negotiate a contract for completing Phase 1 of the project as outlined by the City of Hailey.

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
