

## REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The City of Hailey is seeking statements of qualifications from engineering firms to provide Construction Engineering & Inspection services for the reconstruction of a 2.44 mile long collector street in the Woodside Subdivision.
