Sub committee reports

Met with Josh at SV Bronze and also Christian N. at Rocky Mnt. Hardware. They were both very interested in making signs for HHPC. They each had ideas about how to transfer the photo onto the bronze sign. Neither one has the capability to do the photo transfer. Should have cost information from them by the end of the week. They both said they would give us a cost break and do the job for little or no mark up at all. Engraving would be less expensive than the raised lettering. Also can use Aluminum rather than Bronze to reduce cost. Aluminum does oxidize over time. Number of signs needed would be about 12 and less than 40. Process: We pursue including coming up with logo, once we have preliminary drawings and pricing we would present them to the Chamber of Commerce. Concern of whether we should expand our design to be used throughout Hailey or simply use this design to distinguish HHPC. Express the desire to use the Hailey Art Commission.

Julie Evans moved to: Announce to local artists and Hailey Art Commission that an invitation to artists for a logo/artists design and that our subcommittee meet to get a sense of direction before this process is announced. This should not be open to just the Art Commission we want them to be a part of the process and use their resources.

Sub-Committee Reports

Julie and Frank are on the committee to proceed with gathering information on local artists.

Web site design: Julie and Rob met and went over ideas to spruce up the web site which is accessed through the City of Hailey web site. After many hours and idea exchanging they find it can be more informative and energized, making it more current. Using less text, focus on specific links, add a recent news section. There is some overlap and redundancy on the existing web. Julie presented updated ideas and with her personal passion she is moving forward to follow through with this update. The web site has been changed so the City of Hailey can access it for updates. This web-site would be updated quarterly. Target audience will need to be determined and amount of information as well as related links. Possibility of links to other Hailey businesses for exposure. Julie and Rob will keep working on this project and are welcoming more people to assist in this project.

Mallory Collection Update: Rob was going to check with the State people in regards to archival professionals. The original Mallory Collection meeting was cancelled. Rob obtained a persons name of Linda Morton and Amy Vecchione from Idaho Digital Memories. They gave him a link www.idig.lili.org.

Old Business:

Survey of Rodeo grounds: HHPC found out that the survey will not cost \$4,000. In this 2009 CLG grant we will be asking somebody to survey the rodeo grounds write the nomination for the Hailey Hotel.

HHPC expressed concern about buildings not limited to integrity. It is a perspective from HHPC having a sense of protocol as to how we handle applications. Our stewardship when a property does not request the 120 waiting period to be waved. The waiting purpose is allowing the public to be involved to absorb this future change. It is our job to support other commissions to support to find means to preserve the building.
