Dear Commissioners,

I strongly oppose the proposed zoning district map amendment and attendant applications for a Wireless Permit, C.U.P and Design Review application for dual wireless RF transmission towers in my immediate vicinity.

I feel that the current use of the subject property is already a non-conforming, grandfathered nuisance in the GR district, and that changing the zoning to allow for further industrial and/or commercial uses is wholly inappropriate in this residential area.

The health effects of electromagnetic transmissions are known to be detrimental; and placing additional transmission point source emission facilities immediately adjacent to residential uses would be against the City's over-riding policy mandate to protect the health, welfare and safety of its residents. Presumably the Idaho Army National Guard has the financial and technical resources to co-locate their new transmission towers needs in one of the numerous places where radio towers and EM radiation currently exist, rather than adding a significant new source of radiation in a neighborhood (how about the airport, or Della Mtn., or the Woodside LI area?).

Furthermore, the aesthetic impact of thirty-five foot transmission towers is not compatible with residential design guidelines in the fringe of the old Hailey "avenues" area.

Please deny the sundry applications related to the location of these nuisance uses!
