IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The City of Hailey is making plans to improve River Street in downtown Hailey between Walnut and Galena streets.

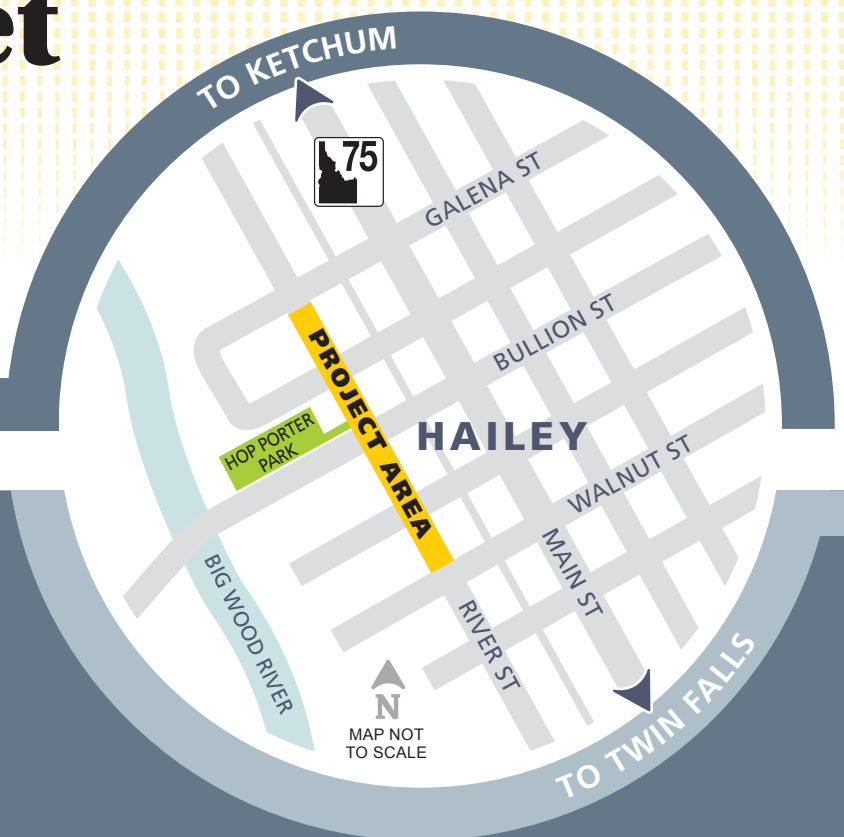
The city's goal is to reconfigure River Street to address multimodal needs and increase safe access for everyone who uses River Street, while meeting the needs of property and business owners.

The range of River Street improvements from Walnut to Galena streets could include:

- Reconstructing pavement on River Street
- Adding width for parking and bike lanes
- Adding curb and gutter
- Adding and widening sidewalks
 - Including a pathway to Hop Porter Park
- Improving landscaping and lighting

Community Involvement

The city is working closely with the community to gather input and evaluate design options for this project. Motorists, pedestrians, cyclists, public transit users, businesses and property owners will have a key role in shaping the project design.

Present final design plans at a public meeting*	Winter 2019/ Spring 2020
Complete final design*	Spring 2020
Construction*	Late 2020 or 2021
