In Hailey, there is **no charge** for the receptacle rentals, hauling and disposal of:


- ✂ cardboard,
- ✂ tin/aluminum cans,
- ✂ glass,
- ✂ plastic #1 - #7 bottles and containers,
- ✂ mixed paper,
- ✂ magazines, and
- ✂ newspaper.

There are **reduced\*** charges for:

- ✂ Clean wood waste
- ✂ Concrete disposal

## More Local Diversion Options

### Building Material Thrift Store (BMTS)

- ✂ Free pick up of almost any construction related item that can be reused.
- ✂ Deconstruction services provided to save labor and disposal costs.
- ✂ All donations are tax deductible.
- ✂ Bonded and insured for your security

### Pacific Recycling (metal)

- ✂ Get paid for recycling of all metal construction materials.

### Concrete

- ✂ May be used for fill on-site or off-site, eliminating or reducing disposal and hauling costs.



Why Diverting Waste is a GOOD thing:

- Can save you \$\$\$.
- Cuts trips to Ohio Gulch and the gas used to transport waste to our nearest landfill in Burley.
- Reduces the demand for raw materials in manufacture new goods, saving natural resources and reducing energy loads.

Materials	Tipping Fee
Cardboard, glass, plastic, tin and aluminum containers, and paper	<b>FREE!</b>
Yard debris, clean lumber (no painted or treated wood products—particle board, MDF, plywood)	<b>\$10/ ton</b>
Inert materials (such as glass & concrete)	<b>\$20/ ton</b>
Mixed garbage (must be transported to landfill in Burley)	<b>\$65/ ton</b>

## 4 Tips for Saving Time and Money !!

### 1. Prepare for Recycling from the Start

- ◆ Don't over-purchase
- ◆ Reuse scrap materials
- ◆ Work with Clear Creek or the City of Hailey for help in determining the arrangement and sizes of recycling containers.
- ◆ Call the Building Material Thrift Store (BMTS) to determine what construction materials can be salvaged.



### 2. Find Appropriate Space

- ◆ Make sure the locations for recycled and diverted materials are as close and convenient to your workers as all other waste containers.
- ◆ It may be more practical to put blue recycling boxes near crew lunch spots for reliable recycling of bottles and food containers.

### 3. Manage Your Program Vigilantly

Determine one or more persons who will be on-site continually to be responsible for:

- ◆ Setting up and modifying the recycling site(s),
- ◆ Checking for appropriate signage on all bins to clarify materials use,
- ◆ Regularly educating all crews and subcontractors, and
- ◆ Monitoring to prevent and remove contamination of recycling containers and ensure recyclable items are not thrown in the trash.



### 4. Inform and Promote

- ◆ Communicate your plan to everyone on site.
- ◆ Include language in subcontractor agreements requiring their recycling.
- ◆ Discuss the recycling program at all safety and regular meetings.
- ◆ Solicit feedback to make improvements as needed.
